

The progression of divorce forces men to start over in life, seeking a new beginning, and requiring in most cases, rebuilding relationships with children, renewing a weakened spirituality, and the redirection of personal priorities in life. No matter what cultural background, maturity range, salary scale or religious conviction, divorce can be overwhelming, demeaning, financially draining (especially if you are proving child support and/or alimony), and an emotional roller coaster that never seems to end.

Fathers Day is for divorced fathers also because of the hard work and sacrifices that many fathers make to stay in their children's lives.

No one can take away that fathers are a parent and aid children's growth in dynamic ways. in many ways with your children. Some of these

ways are visually evident and some ways will manifest themselves as your child matures into adulthood. Through lives as men and fathers have obtained wisdom that we should pass on to our children.

In Proverbs 4:1-27 there is discussion of wisdom, gaining it through life experiences and reading of the Word. "Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom..."

(Proverbs 4:7), and share it so children will not make the same mistakes as parents have. Real fathers guide their children, helping them to "deviate from the possible path of the wicked, and not go in the way of evil men (ultimate self destruction)" (Proverbs 4:14).





TIGER WOODS... STILL ON TOP

Tiger Woods has had a rocky two years — on and off the field — but remains the top-paid athlete in the world. Woods hasn't won a golf tournament in 20 months and has lost sponsorship deals with Accenture, AT&T, Gillette and PepsiCo since his marital infidelities surfaced. Still, Woods remained at No. 1 in Forbes' annual report on athletes' earnings.

Woods, 35, earned \$75 million in prize money, appearance fees, licensing and endorsement income in the 12 months ending May 1. Los Angeles Lakers star guard Kobe Bryant ranked No. 2 on the list with \$53 million in earnings. Miami Heat star LeBron James (\$48 million), tennis star Roger Federer (\$47 million) and golfer Phil Mickelson (\$46.5 million) round out the top five.

Woods, whose annual income has dropped \$50 million since its peak two years ago, remained on top because of his lucrative business deals with Nike and Electronic Arts, according to Forbes. Nike, with Woods as the face, launched a golf division in 1998 and last year reported sales of \$638 million. EA has produced the "Tiger Woods PGA Tour" video game for 14 years now, and this year's version sold a record 225,000 units in its first month on sale, according to Forbes.





GENE DISORDERS

There are many disorders that a person may acquire due to defaults in genes. The consequences of these genes may appear mild or moderate, or may have severe or no apparent effect. Right after birth, or early in life, the symptoms may become obvious. Some are not discovered, however, until adult life. No matter when they arise, these defective genes have been inherited by the child from their parent. Gene disorders result in a defect in one or more of the genes that are carried on the individual chromosomes.

Albinism

Albinism is a disorder characterized by a lack of the brown pigment called Melanin. An affected individual may have no pigment in the hair, skin, and eyes. The hair is usually white; the skin is pale, and eyes range from pink to very pale blue. The eyes are very sensitive to bright light and visual impairment is common. Albinism is caused by a recessive gene, which means that a child has to inherit a defective gene from each parent. The gene causes a fault in the enzyme that is responsible for melanin production.


Color Blindness

A person who is color blind finds it more difficult to distinguish between the colors red and green, or the less common blue and yellow pair because of a defect in the cones in the retina of the eye. The disorder is inherited by a faulty gene carried on the X chromosome. Usually males are the victims of being color blind because they have only one X chromosome, and the defect carried is more likely to be expressed. A female has two X chromosomes, and a fault on one chromosome will be overridden by the other chromosome. Therefore, the female becomes the carrier and never will experience the color

blindness, only males. This type of inheritance is called the X-linked recessive, and there is a 25% chance that a male will be affected.

Huntington's Disease

Huntington's disease causes involuntary movements, personality changes, and progressive dementia. This is one disorder that symptoms usually don't develop until over the age of 30 because deterioration occurs over the span of 15-20 years. Huntington's disease is caused by an abnormal dominant gene, therefore each child has a 1 in 2 chance (50%) of inheriting the faulty gene.




Sickle Cell Anemia

Hemoglobin, the pigment that gives red blood cells their color, carries oxygen in the blood. When hemoglobin is deficient or abnormal, the term anemia is used. Therefore, there is a lack of oxygen being supplied to body tissues. There are many forms of anemia, but one found in people of color is the sickle-cell disease, in which the red blood cells are distorted into a curved sickle shape. A comparison between the defected sequence and the normal sequence determines the nature of the amino acid error. This was the way that the molecular basis of Sickle Cell Anemia was determined, now known to result from a Valine to Glutamine Acid substitution in position 6 of the beta-globin.

It is vitally important for a mother to receive the proper prenatal and postnatal care to fully understand the risks in possible future generations. Genes are inherited and it is always helpful to be aware of what genes both the mother and father can give to the offspring. Therefore, the precautions and proper care can be administered.

You can't do everything at once, but you can do it all in one place.

POISONS THAT KEEP US FROM PROSPERING

Proverbs 6:12-19 NLT

12 Here is a description of worthless and wicked people: They are constant liars,

13 signaling their true intentions to their friends by making signs with their eyes and feet and fingers.

14 Their perverted hearts plot evil. They stir up trouble constantly.

15 But they will be destroyed suddenly, broken beyond all hope of healing.

16 There are six things the LORD hates — no, seven things he detests:

17 haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that kill the innocent,

18 a heart that plots evil, feet that race to do wrong,

19 a false witness who pours out lies, a person who sows discord among brothers.

In this passage of scripture, I would like to point out poisons that can keep us from prospering. These are things that God hates to see operating in our lives. In verses 12 – 15, we see the effects of people with these poisons operating in them.

12 Here is a description of worthless and wicked people: They are constant liars,

13 signaling their true intentions to their friends by making signs with their eyes and feet and fingers.

14 Their perverted hearts plot evil. They stir up trouble constantly.

15 But they will be destroyed suddenly, broken beyond all hope of healing.

They are constant liars, deceivers, and have perverted hearts that plot evil and stir up trouble constantly. Over the past few years, how many of you have been lied to or deceived in business dealings? It could have been that lemon of a car you purchased, or that bad home loan, or any other venture you bought into that was promised to be one thing but turned out to be something else.

These are people who live with poisons in them that give them a false sense of prospering. In the end God will have the final say, and all that they thought they gained will be destroyed. Look how many people have nearly sent this country into financial ruin because of their deceit. From the Wall Street Bankers, to the independent business person who have scammed from the widow next door to you.

One thing for sure is that God does not want you to be named with any of these evil doers! So Solomon tells us in verses 16 – 19, the six things that God hates!

16 There are six things the LORD hates — no, seven things he detests:

17 haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that kill the innocent,

18 a heart that plots evil, feet that race to do wrong,

19 a false witness who pours out lies, a person who sows discord among brothers.

Let's take a look at each of these things that the Lord hates (taken from Mathew Henry Commentary):

1. **A proud look** - Haughtiness, conceitedness of ourselves, and contempt of others. There are seven things that God hates, and **pride is first**, because it is at the bottom of much sin and gives rise to it.

2. Falsehood, and fraud, and dissimulation. Next to a proud look nothing is more an abomination to God than **a lying tongue**; there is nothing more sacred than truth, nor more necessary to conversation than speaking truth. **God and all good men hate and abhor lying.**

3. Cruelty and blood-thirstiness. The devil was, from the beginning, a liar and a murderer (John 8:44), and therefore, as a lying tongue, so **hands that shed innocent blood** are hateful to God, because they have in them the devil's image and do him service.

John 8:44

For you are the children of your father the Devil and you love to do the evil things he does. He was a murderer from the beginning and has always hated the truth. There is no truth in him. When he lies, it is consistent with his character; for he is a liar and the father of lies. NLT

5. **Feet that are swift in running to mischief** are if they were afraid of losing time or were impatient of delay in a thing they are so greedy of.


6. **False-witness bearing**, is one of the greatest mischief's that the wicked imagination can devise, and against which there is the least protection.





President Obama Expresses Concern About Slowing Economy

President Barack Obama expressed concern about the sudden slowdown in the economy but said he is not worried about a second recession and the nation should “not panic.”

This statement resulted from news in May about the new economic trouble and job growth slow down. President Obama tried to reassure Americans worried about high unemployment and expensive gas that the nation is on a slow, if not steady, path to recovery.

“I am concerned about the fact that the recovery that we’re on is not producing jobs as quickly as I want it to happen,” Obama said. “We don’t yet know whether this is a one-month episode or a longer trend.”

Either way, there appears to be little Washington can do about it. Federal Reserve chief Ben Bernanke, speaking in Atlanta on Tuesday, acknowledged the economy has lost momentum but said nothing to suggest the Fed was about to take any bold new action to further shore it up.

And with lawmakers fighting over the nation’s budget deficit and long-term debt, there is no political appetite for a second major federal stimulus bill like the one passed by Congress in 2009.

At the same time, the president is confronted with a slate of figures presenting challenges to both the economic recovery and his own re-election prospects. Just as the field of Republican challengers begins to take shape, a Washington Post-ABC News survey found that public disapproval of Obama’s handling of the economy has reached a record high, 59 percent.

The poll found that Obama and former Massachusetts Gov. Mitt Romney are tied among all Americans in a hypothetical race for president. It gave Romney a slight edge, less than the margin of error, among registered voters.

Seventeen months before the election, unemployment is 9.1

percent. When Obama took office, it was 7.8 percent. Most economists think the rate will be above 8 percent at election time next year. Since World War II, no president has been re-elected with unemployment higher than 7.2 percent.

The news brought the latest in a stream of downbeat economic news, a government report that said businesses advertised fewer job openings in April than in March. There were 4.6 unemployed people, on average, for each available job in April. In a healthy economy, the ratio is more like 2-to-1.



Even if all the open positions were filled, 10.7 million people would still be unemployed. That compares with 7.7 million who were unemployed when the recession began in December 2007. The recession ended in June 2009.

Obama’s early Republican presidential challengers have seized on the economy to try to take advantage. One of them, former Minnesota Gov. Tim Pawlenty, accused Obama of being satisfied with a second-rate economy “produced by his third-rate policies.”

The former Minnesota governor proposed cutting taxes on business by more than half and simplifying the tax code to just three tiers, with a top marginal rate for individuals of 25 percent. The

top marginal rate now is 35 percent. Pawlenty would also eliminate taxes on capital gains.


President Obama and his advisers have mainly played down the souring economic news. Recoveries are often uneven, they note, especially after severe downturns like the Great Recession. The president noted that hiring had been robust for three straight months before the bleak jobs report for May.

He promoted steps the administration has already taken, such as tax breaks for business investment, and a long-term agenda of debt reduction and spending on education, infrastructure and energy research.

At a time of high public concern about the economy, discouraging data can make people wonder, “Well, are we going to go back to this terrible crisis?” Obama said. “And that affects consumer confidence, and it affects business confidence, it affects the capital market. And so our task is to not panic.”

Oakland, CA — All graduating African American male students from the San Francisco Bay Area headed to college in the fall are invited by the Mitchell Kapor Foundation to be recognized on June 8 at the College Bound Brotherhood Graduation - a unique ceremony honoring African American male students from throughout the San Francisco Bay Area.

“Statistics for African American males in Oakland and nationwide are

The Kapor Foundation’s strategy to bolster that culture - by building connections, providing resources, and celebrating achievements - is working here in the Bay Area. The College Bound Brotherhood program also has launched a public, online database that assists youth, parents, and educators in locating college readiness programs in the Bay Area (collegeboundbros.org). HOMOSEXUALITY, ABORTION, AND DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

One of the more fascinating exchanges in Scripture which depicts the contemporary decorum of debate in our present-day culture is clearly seen when Jesus confronted



and debated the pharisaical religious order of His day. John the 8th Chapter illuminates the problem when there is debate with those who are in denial of their condition. The religious elite had no intention of trying to find the truth. These bigots often masqueraded in deception and majored in misinformation deceiving the uninitiated. Jesus began a discussion about being enslaved to sin and it caused the depth of the problem to surface.

Their reply to our Lord's lesson is recorded in John 8:33 when they said, "We have never been in bondage to any man!" Yes, they had become so consumed in their own maliciousness and chicanery, they lost sight of reality, and were living in denial believing their own press releases.

The Roman Empire had been occupying and subjugating Israel for multiple years along with the religious elite. They were enslaved to man outwardly and sin inwardly and blind to both. Certainly at that point, Jesus saw the futility of trying to reach that audience with truth, yet out of compassion he persisted. The elites were determined to twist and malign the facts to accommodate their lifestyle, though in error. They lived in a vacuum of denial refusing to see the obvious.

"Civil Rights" are based on "Birth Rights," and according to the APA, homosexuality and lesbianism is an acquired behavior, not something like the color of your skin - something you're born with. 
What probably grieves me the most is that they both claim Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King as an icon for their cause, when essentially nothing could be further from the truth. Freeing African-Americans from centuries of slavery, bigotry and racism, does not equate with sexual preference, and so in some ways, Dr. King's writings are more relevant, imperative, and apropos today than when he first penned them decades ago.

Like any true Prophet of God, he is and was before his time, yet his words - transcending time - speak loudly and clearly to us today. The pimping of Dr. King by the racist abortion industry and by homosexual and lesbian activists, needs to cease. But since you admire him so much, and like to invoke his name so often, perhaps you might also adhere to his counsel.

Below are some excerpts from Dr. King's 1957-1958 monthly advice columns for "Ebony Magazine" on the two defining issues of this present day: Abortion and Homosexuality. I know there will be those - like the pharisaical religious elite of Jesus' day - who will continue in their state of denial, rejecting the obvious, but for those of you who objectively look at this interview, perhaps it will subjectively help you decide what is right and what is wrong.

Dr. Martin Luther King On Parenting

QUESTION: I was in a home the other day where a three (3) year old child read the riot act to his mother. The mother took

it with a sheepish smile. This, I am told, is permissiveness. It seems to me that what modern children need is a large dose of parental permissiveness applied to their backsides. Do you agree?

MLK: It is quite true that many modern parents go too far in allowing their children to express themselves with hardly a modicum of discipline... This almost “lunatic fringe” of modern child care has been responsible for most strange and fantastic methods of child rearing in many American homes... The child must realize that there are rules of the game which he did not make and that he cannot break with impunity.

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. On Premarital Sex

QUESTION: I was raised in a Christian environment. My father placed great stress on premarital virginity. I am 29. Of late, I have begun to doubt the validity of his teaching. Is he right?

MLK: I think you should hold firm to the principle of premarital virginity. The problems created by premarital sex relationships are far greater than the problems created by premarital virginity. The suspicion, fears, and guilt feelings generated by premarital sex relations are contributing factors to the present breakdown of the family. Real men still respect purity and virginity within women. If a man breaks a relationship with you because you would not allow him to

participate in the sexual act, you can be assured that he did not love you from the beginning.

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. On Homosexuality

QUESTION: My problem is different from the ones most people have. I am a boy, but I feel about boys the way I ought to feel about girls. I don't want my parents to know about me. What can I do?

MLK: Your problem is not at all an uncommon one. However, it does require careful attention. The type of feeling that you have toward boys is probably not an innate tendency, but something that has been culturally acquired... You are already on the right road toward a solution, since you honestly recognize the problem and have a desire to solve it.

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. On Abortion

QUESTION: About two years ago, I was going with a young lady who became pregnant. I refused to marry her. As a result, I was directly responsible for a crime. It was not until a month later that I realized the awful thing I had done. I begged her to forgive me, to come back, but she has not answered my letters. The thing stays on my mind. What can I do? I have prayed for forgiveness.

MLK: You have made a mistake... One can never rectify a mistake until he admits that a mistake has been made. Now that you have prayed for forgiveness and acknowledged your mistake, you must turn your vision to the future... Now that you have repented, don't concentrate on what you failed to do in the past, but what you are determined to do in the future.”

To the seekers of truth in this ongoing debate, I pray you can perceive through his words and feel the spirit of Dr. King and know how he stood on these present-day issues. The iconic use of Dr. King as an advocate for true social justice is as appropriate as the Son speaking on the behalf of his Father. But to attempt to do the same for abortion and homosexual rights, is as using Mahalia Jackson as the voice of hip hop; the fire-breathing Abolitionist, John Brown, as the face of the pacifist anti-war movement; proclaiming Marion Anderson mentored Snooki; or portraying Barack Obama, as a Constitutional Conservative.

It's pure deception!

Social Security: Fears vs. Facts

What Social Security critics keep getting wrong



I've been writing about Social Security for nearly two decades. But even I still have trouble wrapping my brain around some of the system's complexities — from how benefits are calculated to how the trust fund works. So it's not surprising that myths about Social Security persist, often fed by the program's critics. With the debate about Social Security's future once again heating up, these three myths need to be put to rest — so we can focus on the real issues.

Myth #1: By the time I retire, Social Security will be broke.

Social Security system won't be there when they need it. In an AARP survey released last year, only 35 percent of adults said they



If you believe this, you are not alone. More and more Americans have become convinced that the

were very or somewhat confident about Social Security's future.

It's true that Social Security's finances need work, because over the long term there will not be enough money to fully cover promised benefits. But radical changes aren't needed. In 2010 a number of different proposals were put forward that, taken in combination, would put the program back on firm financial ground for the future, including changes such as raising the amount of wages subject to the payroll tax (now capped at \$106,800) and benefit changes based on longer life expectancy.


Myth #2: The Social Security trust fund assets are worthless.

Any surplus payroll taxes not used for current benefits are used to purchase special-issue, interest-paying Treasury bonds. In other words, the surplus in the Social Security trust fund has been loaned to the federal government for its general use — the reserve of \$2.6 trillion is not a heap of cash sitting in a vault. These bonds are backed by the full faith and credit of the federal government, just as they are

for other Treasury bondholders. However,

Treasury will soon need to pay back these bonds. This will put

pressure on the federal budget, according to Social Security's board of trustees. Even without any changes, Social Security can continue paying full benefits through 2037. After that, the revenue from payroll taxes will still cover about 75 percent of promised benefits.



Myth #3: I could invest better on my own.

Maybe you could, and maybe you couldn't. But the point of Social Security isn't to maximize the return on the payroll taxes you've contributed. Social Security is designed to be the one guaranteed part of your retirement income that can't be outlived or lost in the stock market. It's a secure base of income throughout your working life and retirement. And for many, it's a lifeline. Social Security provides the majority of income for at least half of Americans over age 65; it is 90 percent or more of income for 43 percent of singles and 22 percent of married couples. You can, and should, invest in a retirement fund like a 401(k) or an individual retirement account. Maybe you'll enjoy strong returns and avoid the market turmoil we have seen during the past decade. If not, you'll still have Social Security to fall back on.

This year's PHEN Rally partners include the Large Urology Practices Association (LUGPA), the National Black Caucus of State Legislators (NBCSL), and the Conference of National Black Churches (CNBC). "CNBC will work with PHEN to engage each of the nine denominations that comprise our organization to bring the Father's Day Rally to churches within our communities across the country. We will also encourage churches to stay involved with PHEN in its prostate cancer education and advocacy efforts until the uneven toll that this



Recipes

Berber-Spiced Chicken Breasts

Ingredients

1. 3 garlic cloves, quartered
2. 1 small onion, coarsely chopped
3. One 1-inch piece of fresh ginger, peeled and chopped
4. 3 tablespoons sweet paprika
5. 2 teaspoons kosher salt
6. 1 teaspoon ground coriander
7. 1 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
8. 1 teaspoon finely grated lemon zest
9. 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
10. 1/4 teaspoon ground cardamom
11. 3 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
12. 3 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
13. Four chicken breast halves on the bone with skin (2 pounds)
14. Lemon wedges, for serving



Directions

1. In a food processor, combine all of the ingredients except the chicken and lemon wedges and process to a paste. Spread the paste all over the chicken and refrigerate for at least 1 hour or up to 4 hours.
2. Light a charcoal grill. When the coals are hot, move them to one side of the grill to create a high-heat zone. Oil the grate and place the chicken on it, skin side up, opposite the coals. Cover and grill the chicken until browned and just cooked through, about 30 minutes. Turn the breasts over and grill over high heat until the skin is crisp and lightly charred, about 2 minutes longer. Let the breasts rest for 5 minutes, then serve with lemon wedges.

Attitude Check – Get Your “Shift” Together.





The path of the sun is the course we all take in life. In our


